Our readings this week

Isaiah 40:1-11 The cry of God's people in exile has been "How long?" Suddenly, into their longing comes the answer. The pain of separation is ended. "My people" and "Your God" are again in covenant relationship. God's returning exiles, flocking down his high road, will encounter God himself in his glory. The seemingly invincible powers of oppression wither like a flower in the desert, as God shepherds his own, bringing the comfort that the weary long for.

Psalms 85:1,2 8-end Even in our dark world, with its pattern of murder, robbery, economic catastrophe and abuse of relationships, salvation is close. God is only too ready to reach out with his loving care. His captains stand prepared to sweep down, bearing love, faithfulness, righteousness and peace. When God's people cry to him, they need only be prepared to listen if they would hear good news.

2 Peter 3:8-15a How long until the Lord returns? He is not slow but patient, giving us time to draw near. The coming of Christ will bring a wonderful new age, but we should not treat the prospect lightly. Peter urges Christian people to prepare ourselves for the righteousness of the new age by living now in a way that is holy and godly, spotless and blameless. If we do so, we can look forward in peace to his coming.

Mark 1:1-8 Jesus' arrival on the scene will be dramatic. An array of prophecies lead us through John the Baptist who, clad as an Old Testament prophet, heightens the sense of expectancy. Calling the people to a baptism of repentance, he points to one still greater. John has baptised symbolically, pouring water. The one to come will pour the Holy Spirit upon us.
