Our readings this week

Acts 2:42-47 The very early church had a wonderful sense of community. Everything seems to point towards relationships, whether with each other or with God. Praise, prayer, study and teaching are all vital for developing our relationship with God. Care of the community is about relating to each other. Breaking bread, the table fellowship that still provides a distinguishing mark of the Christian church, brings together our relationships with one another and our relationship with God. When we get the relationships right, amazing things happen: and amazing happenings make the church.

Psalm 23 This favourite psalm is built around two pictures: the shepherd who guides, protects and cares for his flock; and the generous host. What is on offer to us is goodness, love and the protection of the Lord as our eternal lot. This poem is about one person. But sheep live in flocks. The individual is cared for within the flock.

1 Peter 2:19-25 Jesus accepted suffering for an unselfish purpose. By trusting God through the worst that humanity could do to him he brought us, his wandering sheep, back to the fold. His action presents us with a pattern and a model for our lives. When we suffer unjustly, revenge and retaliation should have no place in our concerns.

John 10:1-10 There are two parables here. First, Jesus is like a shepherd who acts openly towards his flock, leading them to what they need for a healthy life. Second, he warns us that anyone who claims to be a shepherd but does not come through him is, in fact, a robber. Whenever we follow him, or follow one who comes through him, it is to life in all its fullness.

Pointers for prayer

- Pray for the community to be devoted both to its master and to its members
- May Jesus watch over all those who find themselves in the valley of the shadow of death; may we be instruments at his service in that work
- Jesus' willingness to suffer for us sets a high standard for us to follow
