Our readings this week

Colossians 1:1-14 Lives worthy of God become ever richer as we come closer to God and to his love. Paul is writing to a young Christian church which knows what it means to be rescued from darkness and to experience the love of God. But the gospel is not a call to passive contentment. Rather, it calls God's people to serve him ever more faithfully. Understanding the grace of God should lead Christians to grow and to bear fruit.

Psalm 82 God's judgment is true and fair and cannot be avoided. Yet it is not about things that are too complicated for us. It is about justice for the weak, care for the needy, impartiality before human strength. God has a permanent concern for the poor, the weak, those whose rights are neglected and whose voice is shouted down. Though we may be like gods, it is against those standards that we will be judged.

Luke 10:25-37 This most beloved of Jesus' parables reminds us that being his follower and serving God is not about debating the finer points of belief, but about living a life of compassion, that reflects and builds on the love that God shows to us. We show our love of God and our neighbor in the way we live. Jesus calls us to love-inaction, to see life from the point of view of the person in trouble.

Pointers for prayer

- Pray for the sensitivity to see the world through the eyes of those in trouble;
- Where can I seize the opportunity to share God's love in a practical way?
- Pray that the life of the church, our companions on life's way, may glorify God.
